## NORWAY IPA REGION 2 FRIENDSHIP TOUR AND 50 YEARS ANNIVERSARY 22–28 APRIL 2013

IPA Region 2 Norway welcomes you to take part in our unique Friendship Tour by bus, focusing on our famous fjords along with exciting glimpses into our ancient Viking culture. We end up in Bergen, as guests to the 50 years anniversary of IPA Region 2, together with a great number of Norwegian IPA colleagues, present in Bergen for celebration and for the Norwegian IPA Section National Congress.

# **Vikings**

The period from 800–1066 is defined as the Viking age. Norwegians, Swedes and Danes travelled abroad on long ships, as raiders, explorers, settlers and traders to most of Europe. The Norwegian Vikings mainly travelled west, to Britain and Ireland. colonized Shetland, Orkney, the Faeroe Islands and Iceland. From Iceland, Greenland was also colonized, and voyages were even made to North America long before Columbus.

# **Fjords**

A fjord is a deep, narrow and elongated sea or lake drain, with steep land on three sides. Our trip focus on two of our most breathtaking fjords.

# Nærøyfjord

is a 19 km long arm of the Sognefjord (worlds second longest fjord). The fjord extends to Gudvangen, where the theme park Viking Valley is located. It is the narrowest fjord in the world – 250 meters wide at its narrowest. The surrounding mountains range up to 1800 meters. Abandoned farms can be seen high up at mountain slopes. The Nærøyfjord was in 2005 inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site list, because the land-scape is considered to be among the most scenically outstanding fjord areas on the entire planet.

# Hardangerfjord

is 179 km long – world third longest – on the deepest more than 800 meters, famous for both dramatic and scenic landscapes and for all-over spring-flowering fruit trees. The glacier Folgefonni on the south side. The Hardangerfjord is one of four major salmon farming regions in the world.

# Bergen


Founded at the end of the Viking age – in 1070. Ancient capital of Norway (12th century) and the largest Scandinavian town until 16th century. Now the second largest city in Norway (260 000 inh.). The famous Bryggen (The Hanseatic Quarter) is also a Norwegian UNESCO World Heritage Site. A very scenic city – also known as The Gateway to the Fjords.

# **IPA Region 2, Norway**

Founded on 18 June 1963, as the first regional body (the section was founded in 1954). The region has always been a considerable IPA "engine" in Norway, and currently three of ten NEC members have their Region 2 origins – including the section president.
