QUAIL HUNTING

in Ada, near Kikinda, in Serbia

Common quail (*Coturnix coturnix*), is the smallest representative of the plump terrestrial birds. This bird is 17 - 18 centimeter long, and weights up to 160 grams. Her body is chunky and slightly flattened, therefore this bird skillfully runs through the grass and grain. They nest on the ground and are capable of short, rapid bursts of flight. Some species, such as the Common Quail, are migratory. Quail greatly remembers her old habitat, where she hatched, grew up and, as a rule, always returns in it. In nature, quails are mostly active in the morning, until the strong sun don't burn up, also in the afternoon. Their presence is perceived by the distinctive "wet-my-lips" repetitive song of the male. From all terrestrial birds hunted in Serbia, common quail offers the most pleasure of sport hunting. Also, this bird have an extremely tasty meat, appreciated as a delicacy among chefs.



Participants need to be hunters, they can bring their weapon and ammo, or can rent one from the organizer for the price of 10 euro / day, and the ammo is charged 0,4 euro / bullet.
